Four Phases successfully demonstrated road charge integration with:

Pay-at-the-Pump/ Charge Point: Technological devices and/or point-of-sale options within fuel pump and electrical vehicle charging environments.


Usage-Based Insurance: Account management through existing usage-based insurance platforms and customer accounts. Transportation Network Companies: Technology options incorporated in real-time ridesharing vehicles and applications by TNCs. Autonomous Vehicles: Collection of vehicle and occupancy data from AVs and identify road charge opportunities that stem from AV usage of California roadways.

Key Goals and Objectives:

- Demonstrate the viability of road charge through four technology platforms

- Explore principles of easy user experience
- Establish a flexible, scalable, technology-agnostic platform for continual road charge evolution




#### By building off of existing business models, it is:

- Easy for a business to add road charge as a service to their customers and expand their market access,
- Easy for the taxpayer as a road charge is paired with a bill they are already paying, and
- Easy and cost-effective for the state to administer a road charge.
- A road charge collection option does not have to exactly copy the fuels tax payment experience in order to copy its easiness.
- In terms of public education, we have to explain the problem first then people are willing to engage in finding a solution.
