

CONNECTICUT'S HIGHWAY USE FEE

Overview & Implementation

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OVERVIEW

- Effective Jan. 1, 2023
- Carriers required to register with Department of Revenue Services (DRS)



WHO FILES

Eligible motor vehicles in excess of 26,000 pounds between Class 8 and Class 13, inclusive, under the **Federal Highway Administration vehicle** classification system.




PAYMENTS

- Due on or before the last day of the month following the end of the monthly filing period
- Carriers file and pay online using <u>myconneCT</u>
- Ability to import Schedule 1 from a CSV file



CALCULATING FEE

- The Highway Use Fee is calculated based on an eligible motor vehicle's weight and the number of miles driven in Connecticut.
- Range: 2.5 cents per mile for vehicles weighing 26-28,000 pounds to 17.5 cents per mile for vehicles weighing more than 80,000 pounds.



TO DATE...



More than 36,000 carriers have registered



\$33.9 million collected as of July 2023



\$7 million from in-state carriers (20% of tax revenue)



\$26.8 million from out-of-state carriers (79% of tax revenue)
