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Surface Transportation System Funding Alternatives (STSFA) Program

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
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Surface Transportation System Funding Alternatives (STSFA) Program

- The Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act of 2015 established the STSFA Program.
 - ➤The purpose of this program is to provide grants to States or groups of States to demonstrate user-based alternative revenue mechanisms that utilize a user-fee structure to maintain the long-term solvency of the Highway Trust Fund.
 - Since 2016, the program has awarded <u>\$90 million</u> in grant funds to <u>17 States</u> for grants and demonstration projects.
 - Pilots have considered a variety of options for generating revenue: on-board vehicle; multi-state or regional common challenges such as public acceptance, privacy protection, equity and geographic diversity; and the reliability and security of the technologies available to implement mileage-based fees.



States Awarded STSFA Grants (2016 – present)




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STSFA Multi-State Coalitions (2016 – present)



Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Section 13002-National Motor Vehicle Per-Mile User Fee Pilot

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Legislative Requirements

BIL Section 13002 (b) – The Secretary, in coordination with the Secretary of the Treasury, and consistent with the recommendations of the advisory board, shall establish a pilot program to demonstrate a national vehicle per-mile user fee-

- (A) to restore and maintain the long-term solvency of the Highway Trust Fund; and
- (B) to improve and maintain the surface transportation system.

Objectives. -

(A) to test the design, acceptance, implementation, financial sustainability of a national motor vehicle per-mile user fee;


(B) to address the need for additional revenue for surface transportation infrastructure and a national motor vehicle per mile fee; and

(C) to provide recommendations relating to the adoption and implementation of a national motor vehicle per-mile user fee.
